## Apprenticeship Statistics - Public Sector Reporting

As a public sector, we have a duty to publish statistics about the number of new apprentices we have in our organisation.

The information below shows the figures **from 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020**

Number of employees who were working in England on 31 March 2019:	<b>755</b>
Number of employees who were working in England on 31 March 2020:	<b>699</b>
Number of new employees who started working for you in England between 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020:	75
Number of apprentices who were working in England on 31 March 2019:	8
Number of apprentices who were working in England on 31 March 2020:	9
Number of new apprentices in England between 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020 (includes both new hires and existing employees who started an apprenticeship):	6
Percentage of apprenticeship starts (both new hires and existing employees who started an apprenticeship) as a proportion of employment starts between 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020:	8%
