

The Secretary of State hereby consents solely for the purposes of Section 34 of the Coast Protection Act, 1949 to the laying of twenty-two yellow marker buoys by the Worthing Borough Council below high water mark at Worthing, Sussex as shown on the plan annexed.

This consent is given subject to the following conditions:

1. that the buoys shall not be placed in any positions different from those given above and shall be removed with their moorings within 48 hours if the Secretary of State so directs;
2. that the buoys and moorings be of such strength and construction as to prevent dragging or breaking adrift;
3. that the buoys and moorings be completely removed on or before 15 October each year and not replaced before 15 April of the following year;
4. that notice of the laying of the buoys be published in the local press and exhibited locally in poster form; and
5. that Officers of HM Coastguard or any other person authorised by the Secretary of State be permitted to inspect the buoys and moorings at any reasonable time.

This consent shall not unless renewed, continue in force after the expiry of the period of three years from the date hereof.

Dear Sir

I refer to the telephone conversation held last month between a representative of your Council and Miss Baker of this Department about a buoyed access lane for water skiers below high water mark of ordinary spring tides at Worthing, Sussex.

The Secretary of State has no objections so far as the interests of navigation are concerned to the laying of buoys to mark this access lane and the third line of Consent No. 55280 dated 2 August 1977 is, in consequence, hereby amended to read "buoys and to mark a water skiers access lane; ten spherical yellow buoys, by the Worthing Borough Council below high water mark at Worthing".

All other terms and conditions of the consent remain unchanged.
