Thank you for your consultation of the 1st December regarding the Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA) Update 2016. Highways England are advised that this document supersedes CD06/4 - Housing Implementation Strategy 2016 and CD09/2 Adur Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA) Update 2015.

Highways England has been appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport as strategic highway company under the provisions of the Infrastructure Act 2015 and is the highway authority, traffic authority and street authority for the strategic road network (SRN). The SRN is a critical national asset and as such Highways England works to ensure that it operates and is managed in the public interest, both in respect of current activities and needs as well as in providing effective stewardship of its long-term operation and integrity. Highways England will be concerned with proposals that have the potential to impact on the safe and efficient operation of the SRN, in this case the A27 Trunk Road.

As you are aware Highways England has worked closely with the council in developing its Local Plan proposals in relation to potential impacts on the operation of the A27 Trunk Road forming part of the National Strategic Road Network. Having agreed mitigations resulting from strategic development as part of the supporting Transport Assessment to the Local Plan, we are satisfied that the 2016 update of the Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment reflects this work. Accordingly, we have no further comments/observations to make at this time.
