

## Day 2: Issue 6

*Whilst not a soundness issue the council needs to determine whether the housing trajectory should be added to the Plan as an appendix. If not the Plan should refer to the Annual Monitoring Report and where it can be found on the Council's website.*

As stated in its evidence, the Council does not consider it necessary to include a housing trajectory in the Local Plan document. A trajectory is included in each Annual Monitoring report which is the document in which the effectiveness of housing policies and targets will be monitored and will consider whether any changes are required if such targets are not being met. It is updated on an annual basis, and including it in each Annual Monitoring Report allows the most up to date position with regard to past completions and future projected completions to be reported.

The Council is proposing to address this issue by proposing the following modifications to the Adur Local Plan:

Add new paragraph after 2.24	<b><u>The National Planning Policy Framework requires local authorities to prepare a housing trajectory to illustrate the expected rate of delivery for the Plan period. The Adur housing trajectory that accompanies this Local Plan can be found in the Council's Annual Monitoring Report 2016. It is based on the housing monitoring position at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 (completions and commitments) and the Strategic Housing Land Availability Update at 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016. The trajectory is monitored and updated on an annual basis through the Annual Monitoring Report published on the Council's website.</u></b>
