Thank you for your email of 21<sup>st</sup> January regarding the above consultation.

Highways England has been appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport as strategic highway company under the provisions of the Infrastructure Act 2015 and is the highway authority, traffic authority and street authority for the strategic road network (SRN). The SRN is a critical national asset and as such Highways England works to ensure that it operates and is managed in the public interest, both in respect of current activities and needs as well as in providing effective stewardship of its long-term operation and integrity. Highways England will be concerned with proposals that have the potential to impact on the safe and efficient operation of the Strategic Road Network (SRN), in this case, particularly the A27 around Adur.

Having examined the Draft Supplementary Planning Document, we are satisfied its policies will not materially affect the safety, reliability and / or operation of the SRN (the tests set out in DfT C2/13 para 10 and DCLG NPPF para 32). Accordingly, Highways England does not, at present, offer any comments. However, we would wish to continue to be consulted on any modifications should they be capable of having an impact on the safety, reliability and/or operational efficiency of the SRN.
