After reading the Proposed Main Modifications to the of the Shoreham Harbour Joint Area Action Plan, we propose another modification to be added.

Under section 1.10.11 in the Proposed submission Shoreham Harbour Joint Area Action Plan, there is reference to the South Marine Plan in line with **MCAA: 58(3)**. "A public authority must have regard to the appropriate marine policy documents in taking any decision which relates to the exercise of any function capable of affecting the whole or any part of the UK marine area". However, in your action plan the South marine plan is stated as being "prepared", which is no longer the case. The South inshore and offshore marine plans were adopted in June 2018 and should be referenced as such in your plan, in line with **MCAA: 58(3)**.
