Statement of Representations Procedure

Worthing Borough Council intends to submit a Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Draft Charging Schedule for examination, under Section 212 of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended by Section 114 of the Localism Act 2011).

In accordance with the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations (2010, as amended), Worthing Borough Council has published the following documents for consultation:

The 8 week consultation period runs from Wednesday 24th June 2020 to Wednesday 19th August 2020.
