## **Worthing Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Revised Charging Schedule Consultation**

I am the chairman of the Goring Residents Association (GRA) and I write on behalf of nearly 2000 Goring Residents.

As we understand it, CIL is charged on land area where there are proposed new developments and it is designed to fund improvements to the infrastructure such as roads and schools.

We **AGREE** and **SUPPORT** the council in proposing a higher levy on any Greenfield development within Worthing thus offering a higher protection from developers by making the area less viable to develop but not completely so. We note that the Goring Gap (southern) and Goring Gap (northern) known as Chatsmore Farm have been identified as areas for protection in the Local Plan.

We would certainly support any proposal that would increase your suggestion of £200 to the maximum amount you can charge should you not already be charging the maximum.
