### **Adur Conservation Areas Character Appraisal Consultation Response Form**

As part of a programme of reviewing and updating conservation area character appraisals across the district, Adur District Council has prepared draft character appraisals for the Old Shoreham and Kingston Buci conservation areas.

The draft character appraisals identify the qualities which contribute to the special character of each of the conservation areas, as well as considering how these qualities can be preserved and enhanced through management of change. The draft appraisals also includes a review of the boundaries, and as a result proposes alterations to the boundaries of the conservation areas.

Adur District Council would like to hear your views on the draft conservation area character appraisals and on the proposed changes to the boundaries of Old Shoreham and Kingston Buci. The responses from the consultation will be taken into account in the production of the final appraisal documents.

**The conservation area character areas and boundary changes will be the subject of an eight-week period of formal public consultation from Thursday 25 November 2021 until Thursday 20 January 2022. Representations on these documents should be received within this period.**
