

Donated Wildlife Homes: Terms & Conditions

1. General Terms and Conditions

- 1.1 Wildlife Homes are donated for the life of the wildlife home only. The Council will not replace the wildlife home should it fail for whatever reason.
- 1.2 The Council will place the wildlife home at a location agreed with the donator, all locations are approximate however and the Council will position the donated wildlife home in its final location.
- 1.3 Once donated, the wildlife home becomes the property of the Council.
- 1.4 The Council reserves the right to refuse to accept a donation request or to refuse any request that is deemed inappropriate.
- 1.5 Wildlife homes are allocated on a strictly first come first served basis.
- 1.6 The Council will not be held accountable for any future works, changes of land use or planning changes to the site or their surrounding area which might cause a wildlife home to be removed or moved. Should a wildlife home need to be moved, the Council will endeavour to relocate it as close as practicable to the original location.

2. Wildlife Homes

- 2.1 The type of wildlife home will dictate the location and where installed and the Council will provide a wide a range of potential wildlife homes that can be donated. Currently there are a variety of sites and bird homes available for donation in Adur and Worthing's Parks and Open Spaces.
- 2.2 Wildlife homes will either be affixed to buildings or trees according to their type and location.

3. Payments/Charges

- 3.1 The cost of the wildlife home excludes VAT and includes purchase and installation.
- 3.2 Payment will be taken before the wildlife home can be ordered. Until payment is received, the site/location is not guaranteed.
- 3.3 The Council will advise the donator when the wildlife home has been installed with a location and photograph.
