- How will you monitor the project once it has been implemented to be able to show that it has a positive impact on the local community?
- Is the proposal supported by local Ward Councillors representing the area where the project will be located?
- What support has the project got?
- Are there any obstacles to your group delivering the project? (for example, do you need permission from anyone?)
- What is the plan for sustaining the benefit/operation of the project into the long-term?
- Does the proposal require any additional funding? If Yes, are there any other sources of funding in place or likely to be available?
