
# Low Income Family Tracker Adur household data May 2023

## Who is on the Low Income Family Tracker in Adur? (May 23 data)

- The total number of households in the dataset is 3680(-0.7%).
- The largest household type is single households 2430 households (66%) down from 2441 households (65.9%) April 23. The percentage of households with children has dropped from 24.8% in May 22 to just 21.9% in May 23
- 1711 households (46.5%) have someone living in the household who is claiming a disability benefit. This is down 78 households from April 23.
- 321 (8.7%) are in work
- 975 (26.5%) are owner occupiers
  936 (25.4%) are council tenants
  892 (24.2%) are private tenants
  716 (19.5%) are social tenants
- 483 (13.1%) are in food poverty up from 9% in April and of these 56 (11.6%) are in Eastbrook ward, 54 (11.2%) Southlands ward and 52 (10.8%) are in St Mary's ward. 411 (11.2%) households are in all four poverty categories (food,fuel,relative and water poverty)
- The percentage of households in the not coping category has risen from 8.4% April 23 to 12.4% with 54 now in crisis up from 17 in April 23








#### Households claiming disability benefits

#### Tenure
















Where are our low income LIFT households in Adur? (those claiming Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support)



## Adur ward level data for "Coping" financial resilience in LIFT households




### Adur ward level data for "not coping" financial resilience in LIFT households




## Top 5 wards in Adur in relative poverty in LIFT households

Food poverty is calculated as when a household's total minimum acceptable food expenditure (based on the Minimum income standard) is higher than their income after "priority costs"




## Top 5 wards in Adur in fuel poverty in LIFT households
