It uses two polling districts of St Marys and is unsuitable (no weather protection) for candidates agents carrying out democratic monitoring - comment received via email 14/10/23</p> <p>—</p> <p>Buckingham Ward: AA (AS &amp; AS1) Scout Hut, Eastern Avenue (Northern End), Shoreham-by-Sea, BN43 6PE</p> <p>Good points: Position for pedestrian voters</p> <p>Flat wide entrance for people with mobility issues-wheelchairs and prams</p> <p>Bad points:</p> <p>Limited onsite parking for people with mobility issues. No nearby on street parking and right next to a school-certain times of the day dangerous outside. During covid the makeshift exit ramp totally inadequate and not fit for purpose-wheelchairs and large prams/pushchairs did not have enough turning space on corners and walkway wouldn't take weight of electric wheelchairs. For staff impossible to maintain heat in building-wind tunnel - comment received via email 25/10/23</p>	<p>Alternative venues have been investigated. However Scout Hall remains the best available space.</p> <p>As always we will informally review again after 2024 elections.</p>	<p>Continue to review potential polling stations in the polling district.</p> <p>Ensure ramps are adequate before election takes place.</p> <p>Will discuss fridge options if rebooking</p>	No change

Nearest is in Crabtree Lane or Manor Road. There is also one at the Harriet Johnson Centre but none in North Sompting. This is very inconvenient for anyone without transport or who has limited mobility and need to be rectified - comment received via email 14/10/23</p> <p>The biggest issue we have here is that north Sompting (Cokeham Ward) has no polling station since the Joyful Whippet was demolished. It's an aged community and asking them to travel to the Scout Hut in Lancing with limited mobility just ends up disenfranchising them. Is the turnout down for residents in this area? How is the council accommodating them? Couldn't the council provide a pop up polling station? - comment received via email 21/11/23</p> <p>Is it unreasonable to request that ADWC provide a mobile polling station for north Sompting residents for the forthcoming May Elections? The nearest available PS is now in Manor, not even in Sompting. This is too far for many elderly or disabled local residents to travel. I suggest either Nelson Close or Halewick Park or Halewick Parade as suitable locations for a mobile polling station. It is unacceptable that Sompting North has no accessible PS given the number of residents in the ward - comment received via email 26/11/23</p>	<p>There are no public buildings in Cokeham North ward. (Crabtree Lane is south of the A27). St. James Church Hall has been sold. We have prioritised looking at venues north of the A27.</p>	<p>Contacted Lancing Leisure Centre to see possibility of using venue as polling station but quite a walk for electors. The Scout Hut 79-81 Manor Road Lancing, BN15 0HG is nearer for both Manor and Cokeham voters.</p>	<p>Trial the Scout Hut, Manor Road for May 2024 elections</p>
