

The District of Adur (Off Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation Order) 2011 (Amendment No. 7) Order 2025

The District Council of Adur (hereinafter called the "Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with West Sussex County Council, the Chief Officer of Police and other relevant bodies in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order;

Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 6th June 2025 and may be cited as The District of Adur (Off Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation Order) 2011 (Amendment No. 7) Order 2025. The Order amends The District of Adur (Off Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation Order) 2011.

Effect of the Order

The Order shall have the effect as follows;

- A. Amend the Schedule of the 2011 Order as follows:
- To Amend Article 30 'Payment' to include motorcycles to pay for parking

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle or trailer including motorcycles and motorcycles with a sidecar to be parked in a parking place without arranging for the appropriate charge to be paid in accordance with the scale of current charges as specified in the schedule.

In relation to payment for parking motorcycles:

Where a pay and display ticket has been purchased from a pay and display machine for a motorcycle, the pay and display ticket must be valid for the duration the motorcycle is parked for and valid for the parking place it has parked in. The pay and display ticket must be clearly displayed so that the details on the pay and display ticket can be easily seen and read from the front or side of the motorcycle.

Payment for parking for motorcycles can also be made by using the Pay by phone technology scheme, which allows a driver or rider to make daily payments to park at designated car parks. This requires the driver or rider to pay by phone to park in designated car parks. Each car park has its own unique code, the driver or rider must

select the code for where they have parked and enter the vehicle registration number of the motorcycle or car or vehicle they are parking. An administration fee is charged per booking. A driver or rider can make daily payments or for up to a month in advance in a block.

All provisions of the 2011 Order and amendments in relation to paying for parking, and in relation to all provisions relating to pay and display tickets, pay by phone technology scheme, season tickets and parking permits apply to motorcycles.

For the avoidance of doubt all provisions contained in the 2011 Order and amendments apply to motorcycles when parked in a parking place.

To delete from the 2011 Order::

Article 46(iii) from Part 4 Exemptions: Exemption from daily charge of the 2011 Order "unless specifically directed in the parking place, a motorcycle correctly parked in the parking place"
