

Worthing Borough Council is working in partnership with the Environment Agency to maintain the town's coastal defences from Seaview Road to the Brooklands car park for the next ten years, while a larger scheme to replace the sea defences is developed in consultation with the public. The works will be broken down into two phases.

**Phase 1 :** Involves large scale repair works to the timber groynes. These works will commence in November 2025 and will take approximately seven months. Environmental enhancements will also be undertaken to the planted areas (vegetated shingle) located at the top of the beaches.

**Phase 2 :** Will be shingle movement works. Following the completion of the groyne repairs we will let the shingle natural accrete (build up). Then as required shingle movement works will be undertaken in September 2026 and 2027 to increase the shingle beach levels in areas which haven't built up naturally.

### Phase 1

- The large scale timber groyne repairs have been broken down into 10 work areas, as shown below.
- The contractor will undertake the repair works in each section starting at works Area 1 before moving onto the next area, however there may be a short overlap between the current area ending and the next area starting.
- It is not our intention to fully close the beach in each area, the contractor will only be closing the area of the beach where they are working. However, it is advisable that the public stay away from those areas whilst the works are being undertaken.

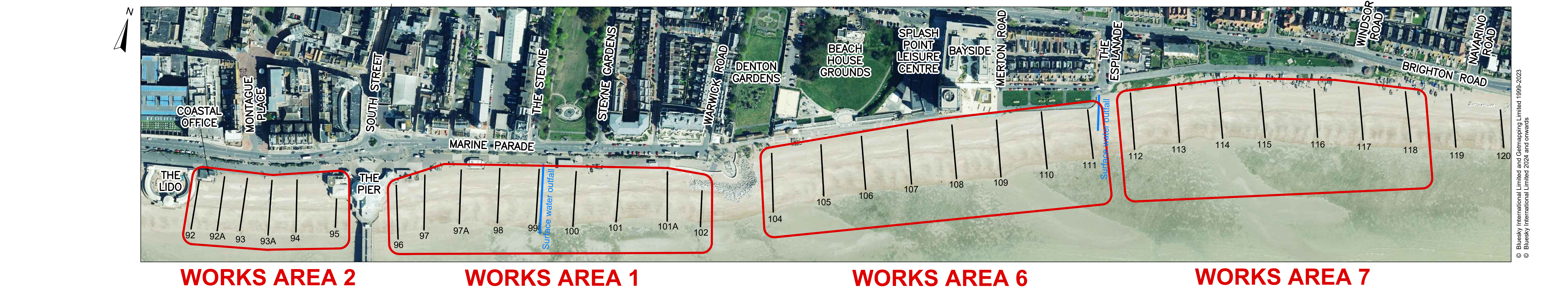
