- Have you got the necessary approvals for your project? 'Yes', 'No' or 'Not applicable'
- What are the potential obstacles to your group delivering the project? - Max 100 words
- Does the proposal require any additional funding? 'Yes', 'No' or 'Not yet known'
- Please explain the situation around the other sources of funding for the project - Max 100 words
- Please upload copies of the following: Constitution or set of governing rules; UK Subsidy form; Relevant Policies (Safeguarding etc); Insurance (PLI, building etc); Accounts or records of expenditure
