

West Sussex County Council
(Worthing: Teville Gate) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that not less than 7 days from the date of this notice, West Sussex County Council intends to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily close the following roads and footpaths at Teville Gate in Worthing:

- Teville Gate Access Road: from its junction with Railway Approach to its junction with Teville Road; and
- The Teville Gate cul-de-sac from its junction with Railway Approach (at Teville Gate House), throughout its entire length; and
- The footpath running from Railway Approach south-eastwards to Teville Road; and
- The footpath running from Railway Approach, eastwards under the road bridge to the Morrisons Supermarket (including the route linking this path to the footway of Broadwater Road Bridge).

For avoidance of doubt the purpose of this Order is to close all publicly available routes through the Teville Gate site. These closures are needed to maintain public safety while the Teville Gate Multi-Storey Car Park is demolished.

The Order will come into effect on 22 January 2018 and remain in force for 6 months.

During the operative periods of this Order, alternative routes for pedestrians will be indicated on site. Access to adjacent properties will not be affected.
