Explanatory Notes - Local Government Finance Act 1992
Council Tax – Apprentice

A person may be disregarded for the purpose of the Council Tax if they are an apprentice.

In order to qualify to be disregarded ALL of the following conditions must be met:

1. The person is an apprentice, regardless of age, provided that he or she is employed for the purpose of learning a trade or profession.
2. The person must also be undertaking a training programme leading to a qualification accredited by the National Council for Vocation Qualifications.
3. The disregard only applies if the person is employed at a salary of no more than £195.00 per week and the salary paid is substantially less than is likely to be received if the qualification is achieved.

If you wish to apply for this disregard discount, please complete the attached form and return it to the Council Tax section at the address shown at the top of this letter. Please also enclose a letter from your employer confirming your weekly salary together with a letter from your college detailing your training programme.
