### Notes

Environment Agency defences are shown with a standard of protection which is against a 5% AEP event or more. Man-made and natural defences which may arise, for instance due to the presence of naturally high ground adjacent to a settlement, have been considered.

The defences along the Adur District coastline are coastal defences. With climate change, it is likely that many of the coastal defences will need to become tidal defences in the future.

At the time of preparing this SFRA a section of defences for the Shoreham Tidal Walls Scheme was still under construction.
