
Equalities data overview




Equalities data - The data for this dashboard has been collected since September 2023. Initially Equalities data was only collected on Council Tax forms but gradually more form types have been added and this can be seen by the increase in the number of forms completed in the first graph below.

The second graph shows the number of Equalities forms completed for each of the form types where data is now collected.

Each month the aim is to add more forms where Equalities data is collected

Number of forms completed for each form type - the chart above shows the number of Equalities forms for each form type completed per month. This is a heatmap and the higher the number of forms completed the darker the shade of blue on the chart. The highest number of forms completed so far were Council Tax forms in October 2023 (33) however as data has become available for more form types the highest number of forms completed so far in December 23 has been for replacement bins (27).

Number of forms completed for each age bracket - the chart below shows the number of Equalities forms for each age bracket completed per month. As with the chart above this is a heatmap and the higher the number of forms completed the darker the blue. The largest number of forms completed every month since October 2023 have been by those aged 65 or over.

Ethnicity data - The chart above shows the ethincity and ethnic group of those who completed the Equality forms and the total number of forms completed cumulatively between September 2023 and December 2023.

The largest ethnic group completing the Equalities forms were white, English, Welsh, Scottish, Northern Irish or British with 121 forms completed between September 2023 and December 2023.

Gender now - the first chart above shows the gender now of those who have completed the Equalities form for each month from September 2023 to December 2023. This chart is a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. As can be seen from this chart the highest numbers are in December 2023 and this would be reflective of the increasing number of form types where the option to complete the Equalities form.

Gender at birth - the second chart shows the gender registered at birth of those who completed the Equalities form. As with the first chart this is a heatmap and the higher the number of responses the darker blue the box is highlighted. From this data we can see that the highest number of responses are in December 2023 reflecting the increased number of forms where Equalities data is now collected.

When comparing the two charts we can see that in October 2023 one respondent who currently identifies as male had their gender at birth registered as female and one repondent in September 2023 and one in December 2023 preferred not to answer either question about gender.

Sexual orientation - the chart above shows the number of respondents who completed the Equalities form each month and chose to complete the question on sexual orientation. This chart is a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. As can be seen December 2023 heterosexual or straight had the highest number of respondents (65).

Marital or registered civil partnership status - the chart below shows the number of respondents who confirmed their marital or civil partnership status each month or preferred not to say. This chart is also a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. December 2023 married (opposite sex) had the largest number of respondents (40)

Religious beliefs - the chart above shows the number of Equality forms completed each month where respondents have completed their religious beliefs. The number of responses has increased each month as more forms are given the option of completing the Equalities form. This chart is a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. The chart shows that the two options with the largest responses every month are no religion or belief and Christian.

Armed forces - the chart below shows the number of respondents each month who served as a member of the armed forces. This chart is a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. The majority of respondents have not served as members of the armed forces however in December 2023 there has been a significant jump to 11 respondents who had been in the armed forces. Looking further into this these appear to be across multiple form types with bulky waste administration and street scene having the largest number of respondents saying they have served as a member of the armed forces with 3 each.

Do you have any physical or mental health conditions or illness expected to last 12 months or more? - the top chart shows the number of respondents who completed this question each month on the Equalities form. This chart is a heatmap chart so the higher the number of respondents the darker blue the box is highlighted. Each month about a third of respondents are telling us that they have a disability with December 2023 showing the largest number of respondents although this increase in numbers is to be expected as more forms now have a link to the Equalities form.

How does your disability affect you? - the bottom chart asks the respondents who responded "yes" to the previous question how their disability affects them and shows the responses each month. Taken over all of the months the responses show that for most people with a disability this affects them either "a lot" (43%) or "a little" (43%) with very few saying that it "doesn't affect them at all "(14%)
